Things in the DC Universe have changed after Superman is tricked into destroying the one thing he loves the most. Now unwilling to let crime go unpunished, the heroes of our world must choose if they are with Superman or against him. But not every country will submit to his new world order and neither will Superman's greatest threat—Batman!

Tokyo Ghoul by Sui Ishida YA IshiS

Shy Ken Kaneki is thrilled to go on a date with the beautiful Rize. But it turns out that she's only interested in his body—eating it, that is. When a morally questionable rescue transforms him into the first half-human half-Ghoul hybrid, Ken is drawn into the dark and violent world of Ghouls, which exists alongside our own.

Naruto by Masashi Kishimoto YA KishM

Tells the story of Naruto Uzumaki, an adolescent ninja who searches for recognition and dreams of becoming the Hokage, the leader of his village. The story is in two parts, the first set in Naruto's pre-teen years, and the second in his teens.

Bleach by Tite Kubo YA KuboT

Bleach follows the adventures of the hotheaded teenager Ichigo Kurosaki who inherits his parents' destiny, after he obtains the powers of a Soul Reaper—a death personification similar to the Grim Reaper—from another Soul Reaper, Rukia Kuchiki. His new-found powers force him to take on the duties of defending humans from evil spirits and guiding departed souls to the after-life, and set him on journeys to various ghostly realms of existence.

Doctor Strange Omnibus by Stan Lee YA LeeS

Vain, greedy and prideful, Dr. Stephen Strange was a world-renowned surgeon until a car accident crippled his hands. Broken and destitute, he journeyed to Tibet in search of a legendary healer. He found not a man of medicine, but the venerable Ancient One -- and the path to the mystic arts! From Doctor Strange's eerie house on a Greenwich Village corner, Stan Lee and Steve Ditko unleashed new dimensions and otherworldly terrors -- stories that remain as influential today as they were on 1960s counter-culture.

Assassination Classroom by Yusei Matsui YA MatsY

A talking tentacle monster with a smiley face who can move at Mach 20 destroys most of the moon and will do the same to Earth in a year unless humanity somehow stops him. Oh and the monster - called Koro Sensei after a pun on the Japanese word "koro-senai" meaning "can't be killed" - wants nothing more than to be a high school teacher!

Civil War by Mark Millar YA MillM

The landscape of the Marvel Universe is changing, and it's time to choose: Whose side are you on? A conflict has been brewing from more than a year, threatening to pit friend against friend, brother against brother - and all it will take is a single misstep to cost thousands their lives and ignite the fuse.

Black Butler by Yana Tobos YA ToboY

Sebastian is a demon who has taken on the disguise of a butler, and in exchange for his services he will be allowed to consume Ciel's soul.



YA GaugA**Lovely War by Berry**

In the perilous days of World Wars I and II, the gods hold the fates-- and the hearts-- of four mortals in their hands. They are Hazel, James, Aubrey, and Colette. A classical pianist from London, a British would-be architect-turned-soldier, a Harlem-born ragtime genius in the U.S. Army, and a Belgian orphan with a gorgeous voice and a devastating past. Their story, as told by goddess Aphrodite to her husband, Hephaestus, and her lover, Ares, is filled with hope and heartbreak, prejudice and passion, and reveals that, though War is a formidable force, it's no match for the transcendent power of Love.

YA BerrJ**People Like Us by Mele**

When a girl is found dead at her elite boarding school, soccer-star Kay Donovan follows a scavenger hunt which implicates suspects increasingly close to her, unraveling her group of popular friends and perfectly constructed life.

YA MeleD**The Beauty That Remains by Woodfolk**

Autumn, Shay, and Logan, whose lives intersect in complicated ways, each lose someone close to them and must work through their grief. Despite the odds, one band's music will reunite them and prove that after grief, beauty thrives in the people left behind.

YA WoodA**The Cruel Prince by Black**

Jude was seven years old when her parents were murdered and she and her two sisters were stolen away to live in the treacherous High Court of Faerie. Ten years later, Jude wants to belong there, despite her mortality. But many of the fey despise humans. Especially Prince Cardan, the youngest and wickedest son of the High King. To win a place at the Court, she must defy him--and face the consequences. **First in a series.**

YA BlacH**Wicked Saints by Duncan**

A girl who can speak to gods must save her people without destroying herself. A prince in danger must decide who to trust. A boy with a monstrous secret waits in the wings. Together, they must assassinate the king and stop the war. In a centuries-long war where beauty and brutality meet, their three paths entwine in a shadowy world of spilled blood and mysterious saints, where a forbidden romance threatens to tip the scales between dark and light.

YA DuncE**We Set the Dark on Fire by Mejia**

At the Medio School for Girls, distinguished young women are trained for one of two roles in their polarized society. Depending on her specialization, a graduate will one day run a husband's household or raise his children. Daniela Vargas is the school's top student, but her pedigree is a lie. And school couldn't prepare her for when she is asked to spy for a resistance group desperately fighting to bring equality to Medio. Will Dani cling to the privilege her parents fought to win for her, or will she give up everything she's strived for in pursuit of a free Medio - and a chance at a forbidden love?

YA Mejit**Labyrinth Lost by Córdova**

Alex is a bruja, the most powerful witch in a generation...and she hates magic. At her Deathday celebration, Alex performs a spell to rid herself of her power. But it backfires. Her whole family vanishes into thin air, leaving her alone with Nova, a brujo boy she can't trust, but who may be Alex's only chance at saving her family.

YA CordZ**Will Grayson, Will Grayson by Green**

When two teens, one gay and one straight, meet accidentally and discover that they share the same name, their lives become intertwined as one begins dating the other's best friend, who produces a play revealing his relationship with them both.

YA GreeJ**Monster by Myers**

Steve Harmon is a teenage boy in juvenile detention and on trial. Written in the form of a screenplay by Steve, along with some of his journal entries, this novel tells the story of how one decision could change someone's whole life.

YA MyerM**The Perks of Being a Wallflower by Chbosky**

A haunting coming of age novel told in a series of letters to an unknown correspondent reveals the life of Charlie, a freshman in high school who is a wallflower, shy and introspective, and very intelligent. It's a story of what it's like to grow up in high school, tracing a course through uncharted territory in the world of first dates, family dramas and new friends.

YA ChboS**Ready Player One by Cline**

It's the year 2044, and the real world is an ugly place. Like most of humanity, Wade Watts escapes his grim surroundings by spending his waking hours jacked into the OASIS, a sprawling virtual utopia that lets you be anything you want to be; a place where you can live and play and fall in love on any of ten thousand planets. Immersing himself into the OASIS to escape an ugly real world of famine, poverty, and disease, Wade Watts joins an increasingly violent effort to solve a series of puzzles by the virtual world's creator.

YA ClineE**Hold Me Closer, Necromancer by McBride**

Sam LaCroix, a Seattle fast-food worker and college dropout, discovers that he is a necromancer, part of a world of harbingers, werewolves, satyrs, and one particular necromancer who sees Sam as a threat to his lucrative business of raising the dead.

YA McBrL**King of Scars by Bardugo**

No one knows what Nikolai Lantsov endured in his country's bloody civil war—and he intends to keep it that way. Now, as enemies gather at his weakened borders, the young king must find a way to stop the rising threat to the once-great Grisha Army.

YA BardL**Field Notes on Love by Smith**

When Hugo's girlfriend dumps him, he's still determined to take his pre-college train trip across the U.S. But the non-transferable companion ticket is booked under his ex's name. Enter the new Margaret C. — Mae for short. After finding Hugo's spare ticket offer online, the two meet, and find more than they bargained for.

YA SmitJ**With the Fire on High by Acevedo**

With a daughter and her abuela to help support, Emoni Santiago knows she doesn't have time for her school's culinary arts class, and that she shouldn't be dreaming of someday working in a real kitchen. But once Emoni starts cooking, she can't help but let her talent break free.

YA AcevE**Challenger Deep by Shusterman**

Caden Bosch lives in two worlds. One is his real life with his family, his friends, and high school. There he is paranoid for no reason, thinks people are trying to kill him, and demonstrates obsessive compulsive behaviors. In his other world, he's part of the crew for a pirate captain on a voyage to the Challenger Deep, the ocean's deepest trench. There he's paranoid, wary of the mercurial captain and his mutinous parrot, and tries hard to interpret the mutterings of his fellow shipmates as they sail uncharted waters toward unknown dangers. Slowly, Caden's fantasy and paranoia begin to take over, until his parents have only one choice left.

YA ShusN**Iron Cast by Soria**

In 1919, Ada Navarra—the intrepid daughter of immigrants—and Corinne Wells—a spunky, devil-may-care heiress—make an unlikely pair. But at the Cast Iron nightclub in Boston, anything and everything is possible. At night, on stage together, the two best friends, whose “afflicted” blood gives them the ability to create illusions through art, weave magic under the employ of Johnny Dervish, the club's owner and a notorious gangster. By day, Ada and Corinne use these same skills to con the city's elite in an attempt to keep the club afloat. When a “job” goes awry and Ada is imprisoned, she realizes they're on the precipice of danger.

YA SoriD**An Ember in the Ashes by Tahir**

In a fantasy world inspired by Ancient Rome, the story follows a girl named Laia spying for rebels against the reigning empire in exchange for their help in rescuing her captive brother; and a boy named Elias struggling to free himself from being an enforcer of a tyrannical regime

YA TahiS**Piecing Me Together by Watson**

Jade believes she must get out of her neighborhood if she's ever going to succeed. She's accepted a scholarship to a mostly white private school and enrolls in Saturday morning test prep opportunities. But some opportunities feel more demeaning than helpful, like the mentorship program for “at-risk” girls. Maybe Jade can show these successful women, like her mentor, some things about the real world and finding ways to make a real difference.

YA WatsR**The Sun is Also a Star by Yoon**

Over the course of a single day in New York City, two teenagers who have nothing in common randomly meet and fall in love. Natasha is a practical young woman trying to keep her family from being deported in a matter of hours. Daniel is a poet at heart, but on this day he is dutifully making good on his familial commitment to a college interview. The two are inexplicably drawn to each other and somehow their paths keep converging.

YA YoonN**American Street by Zoboi**

After her mother is detained by U.S. immigration, Fabiola Toussaint is left to navigate the world inhabited by her loud American cousins on Detroit's west side. It's a far cry from Port-au-Prince, Haiti, and she soon realizes that, in her new world, freedom comes at a cost.

YA Zobol**Turtles all the Way Down by Green**

It all begins with a fugitive billionaire and the promise of a cash reward. *Turtles All the Way Down* is about lifelong friendship, the intimacy of an unexpected reunion, Star Wars fan fiction, and tuatara. But at its heart is Aza Holmes, a young woman navigating daily existence within the ever-tightening spiral of her own thoughts.
