Soon Clary is introduced to the world of the Shadowhunters, a secret cadre of warriors dedicated to driving demons out of our world and back to their own.

Lion and Little by Brandy Colbert **YA ColbB**
When Suzette comes home to Los Angeles from her boarding school in New England, she's isn't sure if she'll ever want to go back. But as she settles into her old life, Suzette finds herself falling for someone new...the same girl her brother is in love with. When Lionel's disorder spirals out of control, Suzette is forced to confront her past mistakes and find a way to help her brother.

Children of Blood and Bone by Tomi Adeyemi **YA AdeyT**
Eleven years ago, magic was lost and Maji, Diviners blessed by the gods, were killed by the King, including Zolie's mother a once great Reaper. Now Zolie, with the help of her brother Tzain and the rogue princess Amari, must restore magic to Orisha before it is lost forever.

Life of Pi by Yann Martel **YA MarY**
When Pi is 16 his parents decide to escape India for a better life. Their journey has just begun when the ship sinks. Only Pi survives, adrift in a lifeboat with the unlikeliest of companions: a zebra, an orangutan, a hyena, and a 450-pound Royal Bengal tiger named Richard Parker.

The Hunger Games by Suzanne Collins **YA CollS**
The Hunger Games is a 2008 dystopian novel by the American writer Suzanne Collins. It is written in the voice of 16-year-old Katniss Everdeen, who lives in the future, post-apocalyptic nation of Panem in North America. The Capitol, a highly advanced metropolis, exercises political control over the rest of the nation.

They navigate the short distance from their homes in Indianapolis, as well as the broad social divides, that separate them from Russell Pickett's son, Davis. But Aza is living within the ever-tightening spiral of her own thoughts. Still hurting from the death of her father years ago, she's crippled by 'thought spirals' and the irrational, obsessive fear she has of microbes and bacteria.

Ace of Shades by Amanda Foody **YA FoodA**
When Enne's mother disappears, she heads to the City of Sin, New Reynes, determined to track her down. Enne's only clue takes her to the Iron Lord, gang leader. But the City of Sin is filled with games. To get back her mother, Enne must play, no matter the cost.

However, Jane accepts a governess position with the mysterious Mr. Rochester which leads her best friend and aspiring author, Charlotte Bronte, to join in a mission to solve a mystery and save Jane.

Carve the Mark by Veronica Roth **YA RothV**
Cyra Noavek and Akos Kereseth have grown up in enemy countries locked in a long-standing fight for dominance over their shared planet. When Akos and his brother are kidnapped by the ruling Noavek family, Akos is forced to serve Cyra, the sister of a dictator who governs with violence and fear. Living on a violent planet where everyone develops a unique power to shape the future, Akos and Cyra resent gifts that render them vulnerable to others' control before they become unlikely survival partners.

Shiver by Maggie Stiefvater **YA StieM**
In all the years she has watched the wolves in the woods behind her house, Grace has been particularly drawn to an unusual yellow-eyed wolf who, in his turn, has been watching her with increasing intensity.

Dread Nation by Justina Ireland **YA IreJ**
In post-Civil War America where the dead have refused to stay buried, Jane has spent her entire life training in a special combat school for African American children, preparing to save the lives of the wealthy. When entire families go missing, she learns her combat skills are incredibly useful- against both the dead and the living.

Not if I Save You First by Ally Carter **YA CartA**
Six years ago Maddie lived in Washington D.C. with her father, a Secret Service agent assigned to the President's family. Her best friend was Logan, the President's son. After her father was wounded in an attempted kidnapping, the two of them moved to a remote cabin in Alaska and Logan never replied to her letters. Now he has suddenly turned up on her doorstep, and while she has no intention of forgiving him for his silence, she soon realizes that she has to help save him from the winter wilderness and the men who are pursuing him.

A Light Too Brite by Samuel Miller **YA MiIlS**
Arthur Louis Pullman the Third, the troubled grandson of a famously reclusive Beat-generation writer, sets out on a cross-country train journey to discover to truth behind the last week of his grandfather's life. Puzzles and poetry lead to self-discovery in this dynamic incarnation of the great American road trip novel.

Foolish Hearts by Emma Mills **YA MiIlE**
When Claudia finds herself ensnared in a school production of A Midsummer Night's Dream, she must also navigate the elaborate politics of her private girls' school, her budding friendship with prickly Iris, and a charming, tentative romance in addition to family drama in this funny, feel-good contemporary novel.

Once again, the Earth is under attack. An alien species is poised for a final assault. The survival of humanity depends on a military genius who can defeat the aliens. But who? Ender Wiggin is brilliant, ruthless, and cunning, a tactical and strategic master, and a child.
