Mr. Laughlin motioned to approve the December 11, 2019 agenda. Dr. Bartlett seconded. The agenda for today's Board of Trustees meeting was unanimously approved.

III. Approval of Minutes from October 23, 2019

Ms. MacLennan motioned to approve minutes from the October 23, 2019 meeting. Ms. Hicks seconded. The BOT minutes from October 23, 2019 were unanimously approved.

Mayor Curry thanked Dr. Bartlett for his service to the Board of Trustees and presented him with a letter of appreciation. Dr. Bartlett's role will transition to Board Emeritus in 2020.

VI. Unfinished Business

a. Photography Policy – Ms. MacLennan

Proposed updated policy and updated/modified verbiage was included in a packet circulated by Ms. MacLennan. It is recommended that the library proceed as planned with previous policy. Ms. MacLennan believes that the policy, as is, addresses many liability issues but also addresses the library's mission. It mitigates business concerns and operational concerns, as well as general concerns with the privacy of minors. With the updates to the wording, it is an opt-out policy. It will be posted on the library's website, in the Children's Department, and in the building. Dr. Bartlett motioned to adopt the policy as drafted. Ms. MacLennan seconded.

VII. New Business

a. General Rules and Regulations Policy (For Review) – Ms. Tucker

i. Dr. Bartlett Edits

1st paragraph, 3rd line- the word "other" should be plural "others." The last line of the same paragraph says "should be observed" and Dr. Bartlett suggests changing it to "must be observed."

Item 3, which is about children left unattended in cars, Dr. Bartlett wonders how the library will enforce this rule? Ms. Tucker explained that the library included this line in the event that library staff must call the police if a parent leaves a child in a hot car.

Dr. Bartlett suggested a wording change in item 7, "in order to remain compliant to state laws" it should say "in order to remain in compliance with state laws." Item 8- will be determined by the library staff. We will update the policy.

In item 8, the last section about camping should state that the library staff will determine what constitutes "camping."

b. LSTA Notice of Intent 2021 – Mr. Tackett

\$8,000 requested for makerspace items, with \$2,000 match. The grant would be used to purchase laptop computers for classes and a milling machine. The grant has not been written yet; this is a notice to let LSTA know that the library will request money. The library will be notified in July or August if the request is granted.

VIII. Committee Reports – Ms. Tucker

a. Kevin Archer is the new board member.

b. Landscaping project on the roof is complete.

IX. Foundation Reports – Ms. MacLennan

Ms. Clark's notes were circulated through email. Finances presented by Ms. MacLennan. Total balance as of October is \$88,651. The Foundation is still looking into banking options, specifically those with better rates. Casino Royale is coming along well. The next Foundation meeting will be in February. Board members are encouraged to donate or become sponsors for Casino Royale.

X. Friends Report – Ms. Bodenheimer

Latest financial report showed that the Friends have \$38,000 in their bank account. Dec 19th is the Christmas Luncheon. The Dolores Hydock program is on January 23, 2020. It is a fundraising opportunity. Friends members can attend for free and non-members will pay \$15 for a ticket. Terri Leslie will collect money for the tickets at the Adult Services desk. Dolores Hydock will advertise the event on her website

and the Library will advertise for the event on our website and via social media. Ms. Bodenheimer is advertising Friends events on NextDoor.

“Makerspace Succeeding After 1 Year at Library”

Makerspace succeeding after 1 year at library

Since opening in January 2019, the Makerspace area at the Vestavia Hills Library in the Forest has offered events and programs for people of all ages, while also offering a chance for patrons to learn from one another.

That was the case last summer, when Aysegul Karaca came in to work on her water marbling artwork. She had been working from her garage, but with the oppressive summer heat, she moved it to the Makerspace area. Soon, other visitors to the library began to watch her work, and this past November, the library hosted a class where she could teach others how to create pieces of art using water marbling, which is where different designs are created on a water-based solution.

“That was an illustration that this was working,” said Derek Anderson with the library.

Anderson, who works in the Teen Department and as the Makerspace coordinator, said the goal is to provide dynamic opportunities for education, culture and entertainment in the area, which is located on the main floor of the library. The space has a 3D printer that allows guests to create their own product for different projects. Anderson said while some schools have 3D printers, the wait time is much longer than at the library because of the number of students using the equipment.

The printer is a way for consumers to create replacement parts for home items, costume props or handmade gifts, Anderson said. The vinyl cutter in the Makerspace area allows patrons to create decals, bumper stickers and even wedding signage, Anderson said.

It's another way, beyond just the renting of books, that the library serves the residents of Vestavia Hills. Being able to create their own products gives consumers a sense of empowerment, Anderson said.

Different programs allow guests to learn what's inside different pieces of equipment, which is popular among children, or learn how to make different items. Patrons of all ages turn out for the events, with the 3D printer classes bringing 8-year-olds as well as senior adults, Anderson said.

The most recent addition to the Makerspace area is the vending machine. But rather than dispensing Cokes and crackers, guests can purchase different pieces of equipment and parts for whatever project on which they are working. Guests do not have to use the Makerspace to access the machine.

The machine helps, because while the resources in the Makerspace area are great, most of what is there must stay at the library, Anderson said. Different products in the machine include jumper wire, buttons, glue, flash drives and filament refills.

Anderson said that, in the future, he wants the area to be more well-known to library guests and hopes to be even more innovative with programming, with a possible focus on 3-D modeling. The space also includes professional photography equipment, something Anderson also wants to see expanded.

"No two days are the same," Anderson said of using the space. "You get to see a lot of cool projects in the works."

More Americans went to the library last year than to the movies, a new Gallup poll finds

(CNN)Who says libraries are dying?

Last year, Americans visited the library more than they went to the movies, live sporting events, museums, concerts, amusement parks and casinos, among other activities, according to a [Gallup poll](#) released.

US adults reported taking 10.5 trips to the library on average in 2019, the poll found -- about twice as many times as they went to the movies. They went to live music or theatrical events and national or historic parks roughly four times last year, and visited museums and casinos about 2.5 times. Trips to amusement parks and zoos were the least common activities on the list.

The results are based on phone interviews conducted by Gallup between December 2 and 15 with a sample of 1,025 random adults, and are an update to a survey the analytics company conducted in 2001.

People were still visiting libraries more often than they were visiting movie theaters two decades ago, though trips to movie theaters have declined slightly, Gallup said.

"Despite the proliferation of digital-based activities over the past two decades -- including digital books, podcasts, streaming entertainment services and advanced gaming -- libraries have endured as a place Americans visit nearly monthly on average," according to the Gallup report.

"Whether because they offer services like free Wi-Fi, movie rentals, or activities for children, libraries are most utilized by young adults, women and residents of low-income households."

Adults aged 18 to 29 visited the library much more than older age groups, possibly reflecting the college students who go to the library to study, Gallup reported. Women reported visiting the library nearly twice as many times as men did, and adults from low-income households reported using the library more than adults from higher-income households.

Makes sense, given that going to the library is free and virtually everything else on the lists costs (sometimes a lot of) money.

Library use overall has fluctuated

The relationship between Americans and libraries is a little more complicated though.

Most Americans agree that libraries are important and add value to their communities.

Two-thirds of Americans say that closing their local public libraries would hurt their communities, according to a [2016 Pew Research Center](#) report, the most recent year the organization collected data on libraries.

"Many Americans are interested in libraries offering a range of services -- including those that help people improve their digital skills and learn how to determine what information is trustworthy," the Pew report reads.

"People think that libraries are a major contributor to their communities in providing a safe place to spend time, creating educational opportunities for people of all ages, and sparking creativity among young people."

But less Americans had actually visited the library in the past year -- about 48% of adults reported visiting a library or bookmobile in the past 12 months before the survey was given, while 27% of people said they used library websites or apps.

The number of people who visited the library in 2016 was actually an increase from the previous year, when 44% of people said they visited a library or bookmobile. But a few years before in 2012, 53% of people said they visited a library or bookmobile.

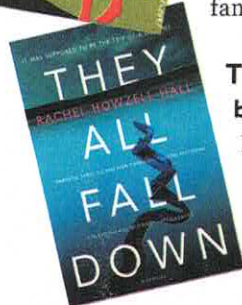

They All Fall Down


